Subsidy Amount

Eligibility – for Exhibition

Definition of Exhibition

 Demonstration or display of products, materials and/ or services by multiple sellers to multiple buyers with an aim to trade such products, materials and/ or services inside or outside of the venue.

Minimum Area Uptake

• 2,000 sqm at AWE

Eligibility – for International Conventions

Definition of International Convention

· Formal meeting of delegates for knowledge and information sharing on a particular subject under an organised agenda

Minimum Number of Attendees

400 pax and at least 50% of them are non-local

Audit

 Auditor report (prepared by Certified Public Accountant of the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (or equivalent) is required to testify the above 2 figures

Is there any limit for the subsidy to organiser?

Answer: There is no cap on the subsidy amount for eligible events

For international conference, how to define non-local participants

Answer: Participants not coming from Hong Kong is counted as non-local participants (Place of origin from Macau and Mainland China are classified as non-local)

Simple Procedure

Pre-Event

Secure the booking with AWE

AWE to verify and check compliance

Post -Event

Organisers to fill out simple application form

AWE to pass the form to the authority

Reimbursement

The authority will provide reimbursement to venue operators for the successful applications. AWE to transfer the subsidy to licensee.

<Approx. 1 month after receipt of documentation>
